



QUICK REFERENCE CARD FOR

Configuring SSL for Outlook 2010

<u>NOTE</u>: The following instructions are for configuring your NCOL Mail account to use SSL settings in Microsoft Outlook 2010. Similar steps will be required for other email clients.


From the File menu, select Account Settings



The **Account Settings** window will appear. Select the **E-mail** tab.



With your email account selected, click the **Change...** button.



On the **Internet E-mail Settings** page update your details for:

Incoming mail server: my.ncolmail.com

Outgoing mail server: my.ncolmail.com

Click More Settings...



On the **Advanced** tab, check the box beside **This** server requires an encrypted connection (SSL). Once this is checked the box beside the Incoming server (POP3) will change from 110 to **995**. This is the correct value.

Set Use the following type of encrypted connection: TLS.

Click OK

Now click the **Test Account Settings...** button to verify that the settings you entered are working correctly.

Finally Click Next >

Congratulations! You have successfully setup your email account in Outlook to use SSL-encrypted connections.
